The Mobile Health Vehicle "Spreads Health" Throughout the KPMAS Region

Kaiser Permanente of the Mid-Atlantic has a state-of-the-art Mobile Health Vehicle, designed to mirror a small medical center on wheels. Equipped with two exam rooms, areas for patient intake and health education, and computers wired with Kaiser Permanente HealthConnect[®], the Mobile Health Vehicle will have the capability to help us provide health care access to thousands of Kaiser Permanente members and the uninsured within the region.

The Mobile Health Vehicle offers preventive care services, such as blood pressure checks, BMI, glucose and cholesterol monitoring, and depression screening, immunizations, health education, and some chronic disease management. It also has the ability to do some specific lab tests and will be able to facilitate the ordering of additional lab tests, prescriptions, or follow-up office visits. The Mobile Health Vehicle is located in the Waldorf area every Tuesday from 9am to 4pm at 3090 Crain Hwy. To schedule an appointment to get your health screenings, call Member Services. The Member Services telephone number is located on the back of your member id card.
